



Jobs go as SAFF put in administration

More than 30 full-time jobs are going from the South Australian Farmers Fuel (SAFF) company.

SAFF, which operates 38 petrol stations across SA, has been placed in administration.

Administrator Sule Arnautovic says the jobs going are about one-third of the company's workforce.

"A lot of the sales and logistics and drivers and things will probably be re-employed, office accounting people may not be taken over but at the end of the day it will be up to the purchaser," she said.

SAFF has been a leading supplier of biofuels to farmers.
